

Articulation Agreement Between Potomac State College of West Virginia University and Allegany College of Maryland

Bachelor of Applied Science Degree with an Emphasis in Business Management

Potomac State College of West Virginia University agrees to articulate Allegany College of Maryland's (ACM) Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree in Business Management to satisfy the requirements for admission to Potomac State College's Bachelor of Applied Science (B.A.S.)—Business Management Emphasis. Admission to the B.A.S. is restricted to students who have completed an A.A.S. degree in a relevant subject.

Allegany College of Maryland A.A.S. graduates in Business Management will receive transfer credit for not less than 61 of the 123 credits required to complete the B.A.S. with an emphasis in Business Management at Potomac State College of West Virginia University.

To receive a Bachelor of Applied Science, ACM graduates must complete 62 credits of B.A.S. coursework, as specified in the attached Advisement Sheet.

However, in the case of the following B.A.S. requirements, PSC will accept ACM course work if a student completed a course parallel to the PSC B.A.S. requirement when completing requirements for the A.A.S. in Business Management at ACM. PSC B.A.S. course requirements are in Bold.

- **STAT 111** if student has credit for Math 221
- **SOCA 101** if student has credit for Sociology 101

Note: the student will be required to select 6 credits of lower or upper division electives satisfying B.A.S. general education requirements in order to have completed a total of at least 42 general education credits.

All B.A.S. graduates will complete 40 credits of upper division credit (300- and 400-level courses) and 30 credits of required 300- and 400-level business management courses.

All B.A.S. graduates will complete a total of at least 123 credits.
